A Quick Guide to Emergency Numbers

In trouble but not sure who to call? Please reference the list below of commonly used hotlines and dial them as needed.



119	Fire department → call for fires/ambulances/emergency rescues ※Can't speak Japanese? No worries: Nikko offers support in 32 languages allowing you to speak with the fire department and an interpreter in real time.
#7119	NON-EMERGENCY fire/ambulance/rescue consultation line ※Best for when you are not sure if you need to go to the hospital immediately or not. Call to check whether you need an ambulance.
#8000	Pediatric emergency telephone consultation line → can call if your child is ill during the weekends/holidays/at night
110	Police → can call if there is an accident or other incident
#9110	NON-EMERGENCY police consultation line Call if you are unsure about an incident and want to consult with the police. (crimes, accidents, etc.) ※If you need the police to come, dial 110!
171	"Disaster Emergency Message Dial" – record and receive messages in the event of an earthquake or other disaster (only available during such events)
